RING SIZING GUIDE

OPTION 1:--- MEASURING AN EXISTING FINGER

1.Select an existing ring that fits the desired finger.
2.Measure the internal diameter of the ring (in mm)
3.Use the below chart to determine your ring size.



OPTION 2:--- MEASURE YOUR FINGER

- 1. Wrap a strip of paper around your finger where you'd like your ring to be.
- 2. Make sure that the paper is pulled snug to your finger, the tighter the better, to find your best fit.
- 3. Mark the spot where the paper meets and measure the distance with a ruler (mm).
 4. Use the below chart to determine your ring size.

DETERMINING WHAT WHITE & HUE RING YOU SHOULD ORDER

Narrow / Band Rings should fit snugly at the base of the finger but also wide enough to fit the widest part of the finger. (e.g.: Knuckle)

Wide Rings (6 mm + wide) should be worn a bit looser than narrow / band rings. It is recommended to add one size to accommodate for extra width.

Please Note: If your knuckle is larger than the base of your finger


- Measure your knuckle size
- Measure your Ring Size i.e base of the finger
 - Pick a size between the Two

A FEW NOTES TO CONSIDER:---

- 1. Measure your fingers at the end of the day when they're at their largest.
- 2. Cold weather can shrink your fingers up to half a size, so make sure they're warm.
- 3. Lastly, alcohol and salt can make your fingers swell, so refrain from measuring them after cocktails and appetizers.

NECKLACE SIZING GUIDE

To measure your desired necklace length, follow the below instructions:-- Use a measuring tape or a regular ruler to measure the piece of string. You may also gauge where a necklace will fall be viewing our size chart.

KINLDY NOTE : --- The necklace is secured by a spring ring which allows you to adjust the length by 1'' + or --- the ordered size.

BRACELET SIZING GUIDE

OPTION 1:--- MEASURING YOUR WRIST WITH MEASURING TAPE

To find your perfect bracelet size, follow these steps:---


- 1. Measure your wrist with a flexible tape measuring tape or a ribbon just below the wrist bone, where you would normally wear the bracelet.
- 2. If you using a plain ribbon, mark the meeting point where it overlaps to form a full circle with a pen or pencil then use to measure the length. that would be your wrist size.
- 3.To find your bracelet size, just add your wrist size with the appropriate FITTING STYLE measurements below. Eg. if your wrist measure is 5.5" and you want a snug fit just add $\frac{1}{2}$ " and your bracelet size would be 6

OPTION 2:- MEASURING YOUR WRIST WITH WRIST SIZER TAPE

To check the size of your wrist, print the bracelet size guide and follow instructions to find out what size is best for you.

A FEW NOTES TO CONSIDER:---

- 1. Measure your wrist at the end of the day when they're at their largest.
 2. Cold weather can shrink your wrist, so make sure they're warm.
- Do you want a snug or loose fit? Well, that really will vary between each individual. If you are buying a delicate bracelet with a thin chain, we suggest doing a snug fit. Most other bracelets should be worn as comfort fit

FITTING STYLE (add inches to your wrist size)
Snug Fit --- Add 1/4" to 1/2"
Comfort Fit --- Add 3/4" to 1"
Loose Fit --- Add 1 1/4"

OPTION 1:--- MEASURING YOUR EXISTING BANGLE

Measure the inner diameter of a bangle you own. Using the following chart determine your bangle size.



OPTION 2:--- MEASURING YOUR WRIST WITH A MEASURING TAPE

To determine your bangle size, simply tuck your thumb into the palm of your hand (as if about to put on a bangle) and use a measuring tape or a ribbon.

- Measure your hand all the way around the set of knuckles closest to your wrist knuckle to knuckle. Be sure to pull the ribbon or measuring tape snug against your skin. Mark the ribbon with a pen and measure it with a ruler.
 - 2. Use the following chart to determine your bangle size.
